Narvik became a member of ISU on the National Assembly in October 2003.

First Elections of the Board were held January, 29, 2004.

The first Board was functioning from January til September 2004. On the 10th of September new Board was elected. A part of members from previous Board were having the same positions in the new Board. New President, Vice-President, Secretary and some Organizing Officers were elected on the extraordinary meeting 10th September.

It was decided to have organizing officers that would be contact persons for different groups of students. Since international students in Narvik are mostly represented by students from China and Russia, but also other countries are represented by one or two students, have we decided to elect Organizing Officers for Chinese students, Russian student and one for other nationalities.

One Russian student and one Chinese student are organizing officers for those two groups.
