

*Agreement between  
The National Union of Students in Norway (NSU) and the  
International Student' Union (ISU)*

1.0 Political Co-operation

1.1 International Student' Union (ISU) represents the international students in Norway.

1.2 National Union of Students in Norway (NSU) represents students at the Universities and the Colleges of Art and Science in Norway.

1.3 International Students are represented both by NSU and by ISU, and close relations are of mutual benefit to both organisations.

2.0 Organisational Co-operation

2.1 NSU have status as observer at the ISU National Assembly.

2.2 ISU have status as observer at the National Assembly in NSU and the National Board meetings of NSU

2.3 All calls, minutes and protocols from meetings and seminars in NSU and ISU shall be made available for both organisations.

2.4 ISU shall give a report to NSU National Assembly and the National Board Meetings.

3.0 Economic Co-operation

3.5 NSU and ISU will co-operate to make ISU financially independent of NSU. ISU is financially independent when ISU receive NOK 200.000 from other sources than NSU.

3.2 NSU will, untill ISU recives its founding from other sources, guarantee ISU a total of NOK 200.000. This will work according to the following model:

Funding from other sources than NSU	Funding from NSU	Total funding to ISU
E.g. NOK 0	NOK 200.000	NOK 200.000
E.g. NOK 100.000	NOK 100.000	NOK 200.000
E.g. NOK 150.000	NOK 50.000	NOK 200.000
E.g. NOK 200.000	NOK 0	NOK 200.000
E.g. NOK 250.000	NOK 0	NOK 250.000

3.3 ISU National Assembly shall every Semester revise the budget and the account for the last period. The budget and the account shall be presented to the Executive Committee of NSU every semester after the National Assembly.

3.4 NSU will assist ISU with administrative help regarding book keeping.

#### 4.0 Continuity

4.1 The ISU National Co-ordinator and the Executive Committee of NSU will meet in the transferring periods when there are new members in the EC, or there is a new National Co-ordinator.

4.2 NSU local democracies should meet with, and assist in the training of ISU local branches and their personnel.

#### 5.0 Local

5.1 ISU and the NSU local branches are both responsible for the mutual contact at the local level.

5.2 ISU local branches should report to the highest body of the local student democracy.

5.3 ISU and NSU local branches should regularly meet to update each other.

5.4 NSU and ISU encourage their local branches to open for mutual representation in each others governing structures.

#### 6.0 Terms of the agreement

6.1 This agreement will replace all other agreements done between NSU and ISU and will be valid the day it is signed by both of the organisations.

6.2 This agreement may only be terminated, in writing by either party, with a six-month's notice.

6.3 This agreement will be renegotiated when ISU is economically independent, that is recives NOK 200.000 from other sources than NSU.
