- To establish a change-sensitive budget plan, with focus on activity-bound spending. Being these funds provided through and by the International Office at the HiO.

- International Café

The International Café and is the centre of all ISU activity. Besides e-mails and normal encounters with the students during classes it is the Café the Axis for all communications with the international community. The whole purpose of the café itself is a representation of the Presence of the ISU on a weekly basis to remind the students of this organism which was created and which works on their behalf only.
