PROPOSAL

Plan for 2007 – 2011

As determined by the ISU National Assembly Fall 2007
12 -14 October 2007

Expansion

ISU Norway will continue to establish ISU branches at potential institutions around Norway, with cooperation from local student parliaments connected to StL or NSU.

A potential høyskoler has at least 40 international students, the majority of them staying for at least one year. The ISU branch must be established with the cooperation and recognition of the local student parliament and the university leadership.

Representation

ISU Norway will strengthen the samarbeid (cooperation) with NSU and StL in representing the interests of international students in Norway, through relationships with the local and national international officers of NSU and StL.

- This includes participation of ISU within NSU and StL local and national meetings and vice – versa.
- This will require increase in the media competence and coverage for ISU local and national.

ISU Norway will increase the number and quality of national gatherings of ISU.

- ISU Branch leaders (1 person from each branch) will all meet with ISU National in **January** (3 months before ISU NA in April)
- At the National Assembly, the number of delegates invited from each local branch should be increased from two to three.

Organization

ISU Norway will create a Handbook (You in the ISU) for newly elected representatives of ISU at the local and national level. This will increase the transfer of ISU Norway's organizational memory.

ISU Norway will establish a national webpage that requires less specialized knowledge for updating and maintenance. This will mean that ISU National will be less dependant on volunteer webmasters with specialized skills.

ISU Norway will encourage local branches to seek funding for hosting national assemblies at their institution.

ISU Norway will work for increased funding from Department of Education.

ISU Norway will work to increase the paid position of the national secretary from 25%-33%.
