To be elected during the ISU National Assembly (NAii11) in Bodø
21st to 23rd October 2011

About ISU

International Students Union of Norway (ISU) is a volunteer, student-run organization which represents the political, academic and social interests of international students studying at institutions of higher education in Norway. ISU cooperates closely with the Norwegian Student Union (NSU), Studentenes Landsforbund (StL), Spire, ANSA, LNU and SAIH.

ISU Norway consists of thirteen independent member branches, a number that will soon rise to twenty, as well as a National Board consisting of an elected National President, four Vice Presidents and a National Secretary.

About the position

ISU will elect a National President in the National Assembly in Bodø 21st - 23rd October 2011 into a 38% position with salary Level 14 according to the Norwegian Government regulation. The position will be available from October 23rd for a period of 13 months.

Main Tasks

- Representing international students towards various Norwegian authorities, partners and organizations
- Coordinating the work of the National Board and Local Branches
- Organization in cooperation with the National Secretary of 1 ISU National Assembly and 2 leadership meetings per academic year
- Representing ISU at various partner meetings
- Representing ISU at different national and regional conferences
- Responsible for ISU's National finances
- Responsible for securing yearly funds for ISU from the Norwegian Ministry of Education and Research and other sources
- Responsible for maintaining and administrating an office shared with the National Secretary and National Board
- Lead the work of ISU in establishing new ISU branches in Norway and abroad
